

STUDY QUESTIONS FOR
THE HEALTHY SOUL, PART 12: THE BEST THINGS IN LIFE

Introduction

1. How has the recent economic upheaval affected you personally? Did it change your behavior in any way?
2. How much of that change was financially necessary and how much was emotional?
3. How has the impact of it affected your feelings on a day to day basis?

Genesis 1:1-31

1. Read through the text verse by verse, stopping to describe things in God's creation which you treasure.
2. What do you do, specifically, in the act of treasuring?
3. Have you had opportunity to help others treasure the same things?

Jeremiah 28:8-11

1. Why do you think people discount and dismiss the treasures of God?
2. What do you think was the Israelite kings motive for having a group of so-called prophets who only tell them what they want to hear? Are there such "prophets" today?
3. Tell a personal example of how a fresh awareness of the value of the truth of God impacted your life.
4. Tell an example of how knowing that God has plans for you, to give you a future and a hope, gave you the strength to carry on or to overcome a difficulty.
5. Read Lamentations 3:22-23. How have you experienced the love of God on a personal level? How does it impact the way you live day to day?

Jeremiah 29:12-13

1. What did seeking God look like before the nation Israel was founded? What did it look like during the national program of Israel?
2. Was it possible to tell when someone was faking then? Is it possible now? How do you know when you are faking devotion?

Ephesians 2:4-7

1. What were you like when you were spiritually dead? Be honest.
2. What have been the changes in your life which prove to you that you have been given eternal life?
3. What does it mean for you to be a son or daughter of the King of Kings? Have you ever used your authority in Christ to impact the spirit world?
4. How does the knowledge of perpetual divine favor impact your life? Are you always aware of it?
5. Describe your personal awareness of the meaninglessness of possessions and riches compared to our riches in Christ. Had any notable cases of buyer's remorse?
6. Tell a story of someone who found the key to the treasures of God.
